SCHOOL STRATEGIES, COMMITMENTS, & ACTION STEPS

Reading Strategy:

Statement of Commitment: We commit to implementing all components of literacy instruction while providing Tier 1 instruction so that students will have the optimum amount of instructional time with Tier 1 and Tier 2 or 3 when necessary.

Action Steps:

- Establish a clear communication process between interventionists and general education teachers to ensure students receive sufficient time in both core instruction and intervention, and to align instructional strategies across all settings and educators.
- Provide professional learning on effectively integrating writing and grammar into small group reading instruction in a purposeful and meaningful way
- Offer professional learning focused on deepening understanding of grade-level standards and effective differentiation strategies to meet the diverse needs of learners
- Develop and implement lessons that build students' test-taking skills and strategies

Mathematics Strategy:

Statement of Commitment: We commit to implementing a multi-tiered system of supports for instruction and intervention so that students will have increased access and proficiency with grade/course-level standards.

Action Steps:

- Offer professional learning focused on supporting students through productive struggle with Launch Engage Debrief Explain (LEDE), facilitating rich mathematical discourse, and posing purposeful, standards-aligned questions that engage students in reasoning about mathematics
- Provide professional learning on effectively and meaningful integrating math fact fluency into daily instruction
- Strengthen ITL capacity to support deeper collaborative planning, with a focus on unpacking standards, effective use of manipulatives, and differentiated instruction
- Build interventionists' content knowledge to ensure targeted, high-yielding, standards-based support for students as well as ensure alignment of instructional strategies across all settings and educators
- Develop and implement lessons that build students' test-taking skills and strategies

Attendance Strategy:

Statement of Commitment: We commit to creating a positive school culture that prioritizes healthy relationships and grows a culture of belonging so that students will be more likely to come to school.

Action Steps:

- Provide professional learning on the attendance process and the importance of care and concern calls in addition to positive touch points
- Increase opportunities to excite and motivate students to come to school through both intangible and tangible reinforcements
- Implement an Attendance Outreach team
- Provide a bus to walkers whose attendance is impacted by inclement weather, daylight, and long distances

Statement of Commitment: We commit to creating a positive school culture that prioritizes healthy relationships and grows a culture of belonging so that students will experience less exclusionary discipline as evidenced by overall suspension rates.

Action Steps:

- Provide differentiated professional learning to staff around school-wide behavior
- Gather student voice on our LWES culture, environment, learning, etc. through suggestion boxes and address accordingly
- Increase engaging recess opportunities for students
